## Taxis & Auto-rickshaws

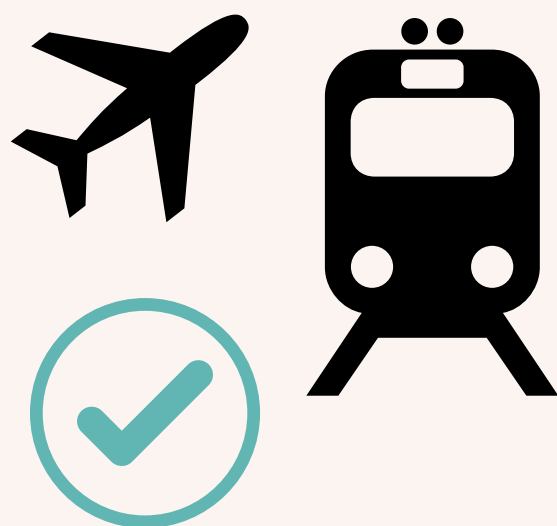
Taxis & Auto-rickshaws will be permitted for hire only in an emergency



## Flights and Trains

Scheduled travel is operational.

*Flight/Train ticket will serve as passes for transportation to board Flight/Train*



## Educational Institutions

All Education Institutes to remain closed

*However, examinations already scheduled will be permitted in accordance with Covid restrictions. Students can use their Admission ticket as a travel pass.*



## Hotels & Restaurants

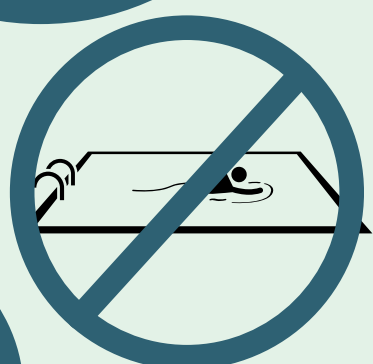
Hospitality Services available only for Housing Health, Police, Government officials, Healthcare workers & Stranded persons (Including Tourist)

*Hotels/Restaurants/Eateries permitted to carry out only takeaway/homedelivery*

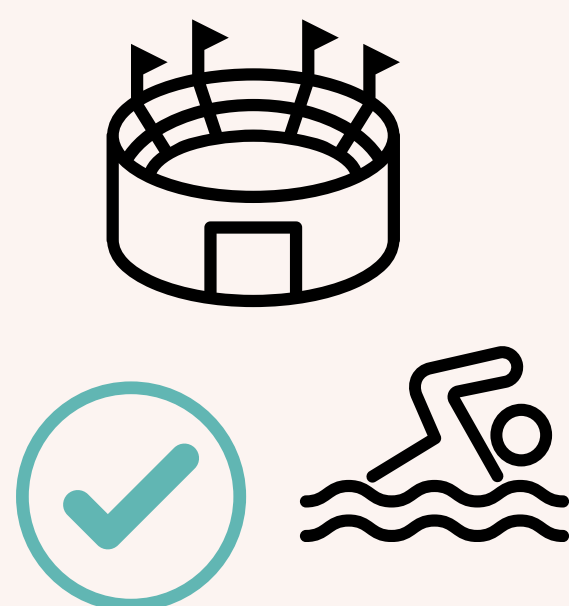


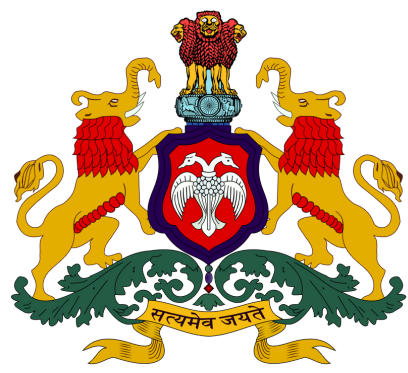
## Places of Mass Gathering

All cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, sports complexes, stadia, swimming pools, entertainment parks, clubs, theatres, bars and auditoriums, assembly halls, places of worship, and similar places will remain closed for Public



Stadia and playgrounds are allowed for organizing sports events and practice without spectators. Swimming pools approved by the Swimming Federation of India to be opened only for training purposes.





# Guidelines to Break the Chain of Covid-19 Transmission No.2 with effect from 9pm, 27th April to 6am, 12th May

## Health Services Remain Functional including AYUSH & Veterinary Hospitals

### Medical Facilities

All hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, labs, collection centres, Telemedicine facilities, dispensaries, pharmacies, chemist, Jan Aushadhi Kendras, Blood Banks, home care providers and all kinds of medicine shops including medical equipment shops will be functional.



All pharmaceutical and research labs will remain functional.



### Manufacturing Units

All manufacturing units of drugs, pharmaceuticals, medical devices, medical oxygen, their packing material, raw material and intermediates will be operational.



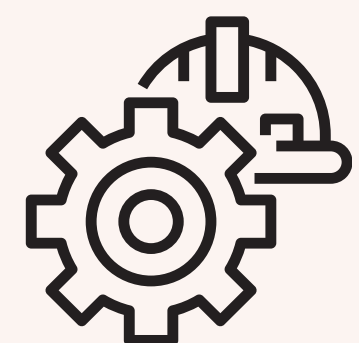
### Movement

Movement of all medical, paramedics, nurses, scientists, labs technicians, mid-wives and other hospital support services is allowed. Patients and their attendants requiring emergency need for movement shall be allowed to move.



### Construction

All construction permitted.



## Agriculture & Social Sector

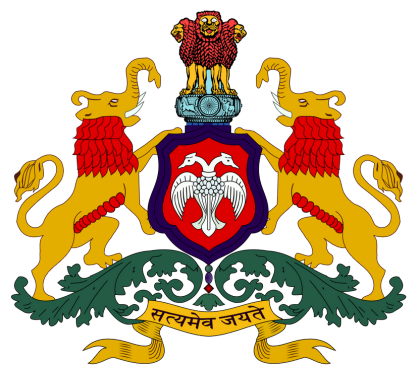
All agriculture and allied activities, including shops and godowns, related to farming, custom hiring centers, machineries are permitted outside containment zones. Allied activities include Fisheries, Poultry, Meat, Dairy, etc will also be permitted.



### MNREGA

MNREGA works to be allowed with strict adherence to National Directives for COVID 19 management.





# Guidelines to Break the Chain of Covid-19 Transmission No.3 with effect from 9pm, 27th April to 6am, 12th May

## Public utilities

Public utilities (including petroleum, CNG, LPG, PNG), power generation and transmission units, post offices, Disaster management and Early Warning Agencies will remain functional.



## Goods & Cargo

Movement of all types of goods and cargo (outside containment zones) will be permitted.



## Buses & Vehicles

Movement of buses or passenger vehicles allowed only in cases of emergency.



## Travel to Work

Officers/Personnel will be allowed to travel only with valid ID card issued by their place of work for permitted activities.



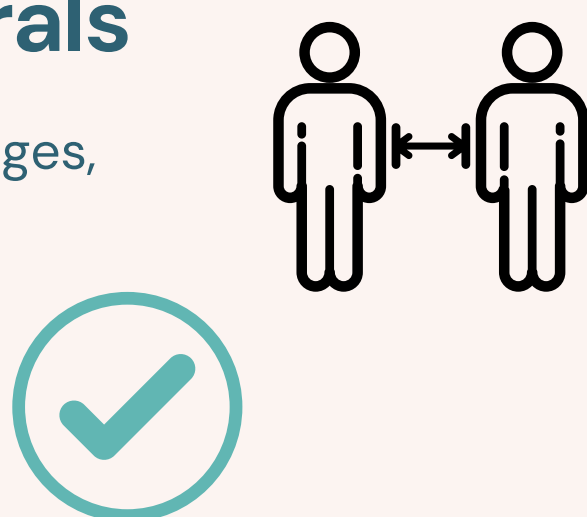
## Vaccination

Movement for the purpose of vaccination and testing shall be permitted with minimal proof.



## Marriages & Funerals

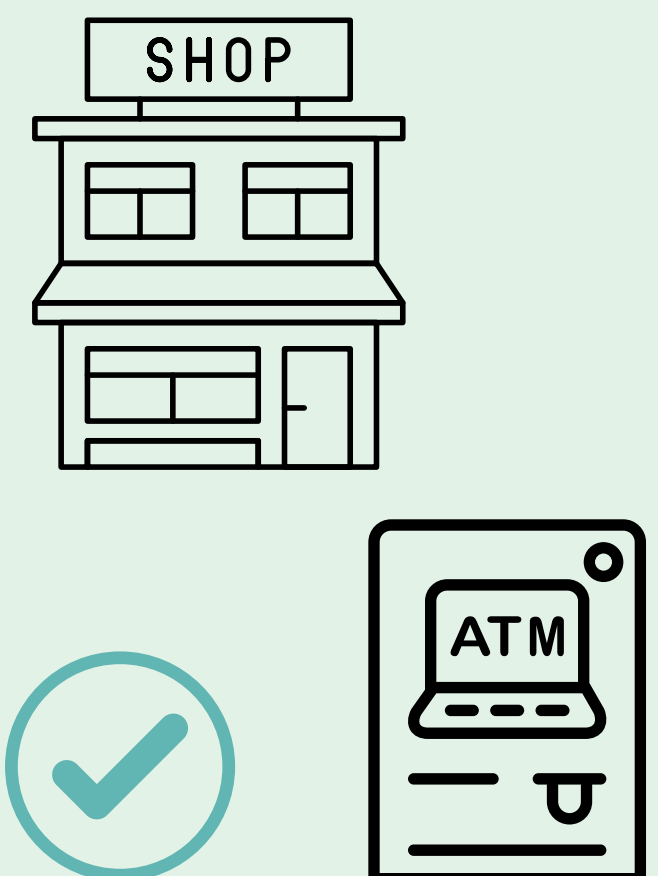
Maximum 50 people for marriages, maximum 5 people for cremation/funerals



## Shops & Banks

Shops dealing with essential items like food and standalone liquor shops will be allowed to function from 6am to 10am. Home delivery will be encouraged.

Banks, Insurance offices and ATM will be functional.







# Guidelines to Break the Chain of Covid-19 Transmission No.4 with effect from 9pm, 27th April to 6am, 12th May

## Night Curfew

Movement of individuals is strictly prohibited between 9:00 pm to 6:00am

*Except for essential activities.*



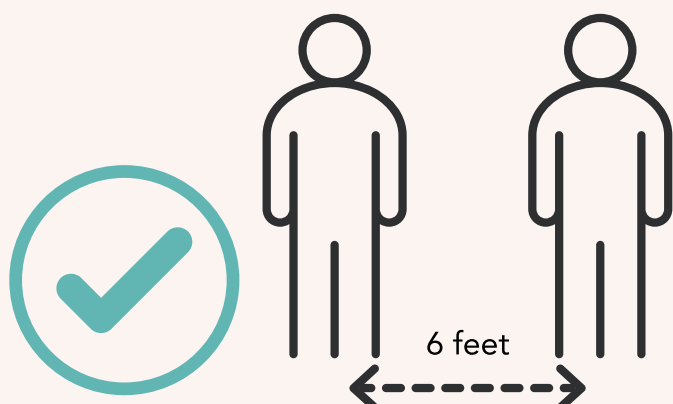
## Wear a Mask

It is compulsory to wear a face mask, a fine will be imposed on being found without wearing a mask.



## Social distancing

Individuals must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet.



## Spitting in Public

Spitting in public places will be punishable with a fine.



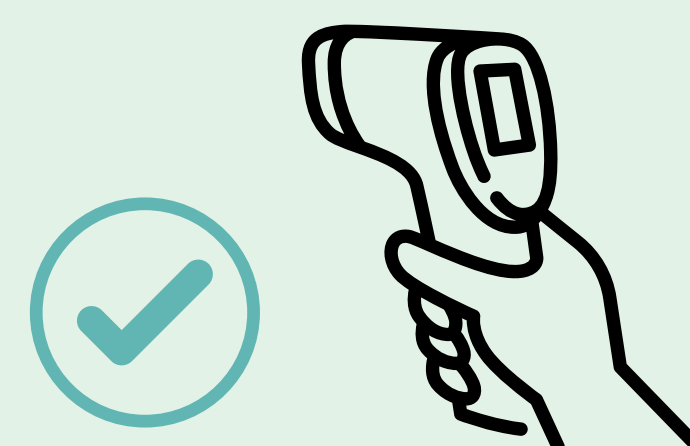
## Work from Home

Working from home is encouraged when possible.



## Screening & Hygiene

Thermal scanning, hand wash/sanitizer will be placed at all entry and exit points and common areas for the Workplace



## Frequent Sanitization

Entire workplace, common facilities and all points which come into contact will be sanitized
